

Information on “Break-in” Period for Larger Barrels

While the MGC was designed for use with a wide range of barrel sizes, larger sizes like 12 or 10 gauge may require a little break-in period for one-handed use. You can speed up the break-in time by working the foam portion with your hands or slipping it on and off the barrel. Eventually you will be able to slip the gun in and remove it from the MGC with just one hand.

In the meantime, grab the barrel at the same height as the MGC foam holder, and use your thumb to push against one side of the foam as you pull the barrel from the holder.

Basic Use Information

Wipe a small area clean with your hand or glove to place the MGC. Lean your gun into the MGC as vertically as possible (if it's leaning too much to the left or right, it could slide). Remember, NEVER use the Magnet Gun Caddy with a loaded gun.

Use with Gun Safes and Gun Lockers

The MGC also provides a great way to stage firearms going in and out of storage – just place the MGC on the outside of the storage unit for a place to set your gun while opening and closing the storage unit.

The MGC can maximize interior capacity of gun lockers too. Just place the MGC anywhere and at any height you need to fill spaces open in your locker. It works Great with Fishing Poles Too!

The Magnet Gun Caddy holds most gun sizes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Estimate the best height to place the Magnet Gun Caddy on the side of your vehicle or metal surface by leaning your unloaded gun up close to the vehicle – the point where the barrel comes closest to the side of the vehicle is where the Magnet Gun Caddy should be placed.
2. Make sure the area the Magnet Gun Caddy is going to be placed is clean.
3. Make sure your gun is not loaded, and then lean the gun up so the gun barrel rests inside the holder. **The gun should be positioned as vertically as possible.** See our online video for a demonstration.

WARNINGS:

1. The Magnet Gun Caddy is not intended to be used with a loaded gun. A loaded gun that falls to the ground could cause accidental discharge and serious injury.
2. The Magnet Gun Caddy is not intended to support the full weight of the gun off the ground.
3. Do not use the Magnet Gun Caddy on a dirty surface as doing so could cause minor scratches to the surface under the magnet.
